On occasion of its 200 years of independence: The innovation winner Peru is a partner of the Global Food Summit at the Berlin Science Week on November 5, 2021.

For the third time now, the Global Food Summit will participate at the Berlin Science Week on November 5, 2021. This year's theme is: "Foodtropolis - Urban.Circular.Food & Climate Change". Peru's Ambassador to Germany, H.E. Elmer Schialer Salcedo, will provide the welcome speech. Stephan Becker-Sonnenschein, Head and Founder of the Global Food Summit, explains:

"This year, Peru is celebrating its 'Bicentenario', that is, its 200 years of independence from the Spanish crown. To mark the occasion, the country has set two extraordinary sustainability goals: First, to completely reduce the deforestation of its forests to zero before the end of the year, and to replace it with sustainable forestry. Secondly, the construction of a new city north of Lima is to begin soon: the so-called "Ciudad Bicentenario," which will meet all sustainability criteria with regard to climate change. Among other things, around 2,000 hectares will be reforested and irrigated with treated wastewater. The new city is planned for around 115,000 inhabitants.

It is a very special honor for us, in this anniversary year, to welcome the Peruvian Ambassador to Germany, H. E. Elmer Schialer Salcedo, for a welcome speech at the Global Food Summit at the Berlin Science Week:
